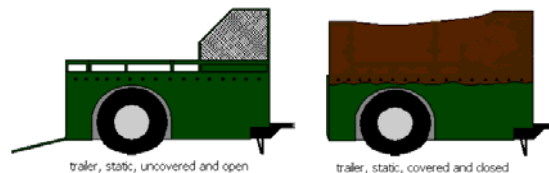

### 1.0 List of Vehicles and Ships in Royal Security Police Service Fleet

The Royal Security Police Service is currently in the process of purchasing various vehicles and ships for our fleet. As of publication of this document, the order for Anthelia Automotive Carrier I platforms is 67% complete, with final delivery scheduled for 22 Sep 2006. Deliveries of Anthelia Automotive Mobile Coupé 2 (RSPS Variant) are completed, as is delivery of Königreich Reichlau Schiffbau C-65 50m small cutters. A tender for acquisition of general purpose trailers is outstanding.

### 2.0 Allocation of Vehicles and Ships to Commands

#### *C-65 Cutter*

All C-65 cutters are assigned to the Islands Enforcement Region. These vessels are used for maritime drug-interdiction operations as well as customs and fisheries patrols. When necessary, the vessels may be tasked by the Royal Police Division's Special Services for carrying out operations in the maritime theatre.

As of 1 January 2007, 1 cutter from Atwood is being forward deployed to the Royal Colony of Lusatia. It will leave port at Lusatia following completion of its deployment on 15 June 2007. A cutter from Troy will depart on 1 June 2007 as a replacement and return to homeport on 15 December 2007.

*Anthelia Automotive Carrier I (RSPS Variant)*

The Carrier I platforms are not allocated to any specific division or unit of the Royal Security Police Service. Instead, the platforms are distributed to regional and metropolis commands where they may be assigned for roles, as required, by the commanders of those theatres. The twenty-one vehicles currently in the fleet have been assigned as follows:

- Regional Police North, Regional Police West, Regional Police Central: 3 vehicles each;
- Regional Police South: 1 vehicle assigned;
- Islands Enforcement Region: 3 vehicles assigned;
- Metropolises: Lonenberg, Reichstadt, Aremstadt, Ganden: 2 vehicles each.

Table 1 shows the current and planned home-stations for individual Carrier I platforms:

As of August 2006, no further acquisition of Carrier I platforms is being planned. On 22 Aug 2006, a tender was released calling for industry bids on the acquisition of fourteen (14) general purpose

trailers. These trailers are to be compatible with the Carrier I platform and, pending successful tendering process, will be allocated as needed to necessary home-stations of Carrier I platforms.

#### ATLAS General Purpose Trailer Allocations

The fourteen (14) Anthelia Automotive ATLAS General Purpose Trailers acquired by the Royal Security Police Service in October 2006 will be deployed as follows amongst the metropolitan forces and regional forces:

- Each metropolitan force (x3): 2 trailers (6 total)
- Lonenberg Municipal Police: 2 trailers
- Regional Police North: 2 trailers
- Regional Police West: 2 trailers
- Regional Police Central: 2 trailers
- Regional Police South: 0 trailers – will utilize those allocated to the Ganden Metropolitan Police as required and available.
- Islands Enforcement Region: 2 trailers (one stationed on each island)

*Anthelia Automotive Mobile 2 Coupé (RSPS Variant)*

The Mobile 2 Coupé platforms are allocated to regional and metropolitan policing divisions on an as needed individual basis. These platforms are assigned to the largest policing divisions first due to their limited availability. Policing divisions which encompass the medium- and small-sized municipalities in greater numbers than the large- and metropolis-sized municipalities are less likely to receive these platforms at this time. An exception is made for regional policing headquarters that are situated in the smaller municipalities. These headquarters will be allocated with some platforms on an as needed basis. Planning is currently underway on a further acquisition of additional platforms for this fleet pending performance reviews to be completed by the end of September 2006.

The current fleet of Mobile 2 Coupé platforms is distributed as follows:

### 3.0 Future Plans

All available funds allocated for RSPS procurement in CY2006 have been spent. New procurements in 2007 are currently under consideration pending approved budgetary funding. Current priority of the administration is to expand the fleet of Mobile 2 Coupé, or equivalent, vehicles throughout the remaining municipalities to allow for more effective policing coverage. Additional Carrier I platforms, or equivalent, may also be procured, though this is not a priority purchase at this time.

Reduction in the Cutter fleet may also occur with greater role of the Royal Navy in patrolling and policing Gotzborg's maritime boundaries. This is to be a subject of an inter-force meeting in 2007.
