As requested, the following is a status report of current ongoing Royal Security Police Service activities.

1. A training programme is under development so that new officers to the Service can become more familiar with the Service and its procedures. This programme is currently awaiting the development of further scenario-related questions before being placed in official use.
2. On 11 October 2006, heightened tensions with the Kingdom of Paulovia precipitated the issuance of a national security alert to all personnel. All officers responded to the alert within four hours. Alert was rescinded on 13 October.
3. Development of uniforms and other imagery for the Service is currently being performed internally. Final images to be confirmed and forwarded to His Royal Majesty's Office as received.
4. Development of a website for the Service has been initiated.
5. The Service has received all outstanding vehicles ordered from Anthelia Automotive. Current vehicle fleet now stands at: 21 Carrier I; 40 Mobilé Coupe 2; 14 General Purpose Trailer; 4 C65 Cutter.
6. Review is underway concerning future expansion and realignment of vehicle fleet. Result not expected until 2007.
