SUBJECT: Dissolution of the Gotzborg Eagle news service

Despite the best attempts of this Ministry to reinvigorate the Gotzborg Eagle news service over the past year, the publication remains stagnant and has not published in several months. In June 2006, I appointed Duchess Angel Davis to the position of Chief Editor following her expression of interest in renewing the Eagle as a viable publication.

Following discussions with Duchess Davis earlier this week, it was determined that she no longer wished to participate actively in the Gotzborg Eagle for personal reasons. As a result of this determination, I have decided that it is no longer in the interests of this Ministry to expend manpower on trying to bring the Eagle back to life.

Effective Monday, 17 July 2006, I hereby order that the Gotzborg Eagle formally cease operations and its past publications be archived. All staff positions, as of that date, are hereby terminated. Duchess Davis is further released from her employment with the Ministry of Communications and Information effective 14 July 2006.
