Re: Changes to the Media Licensing Process

Over the past few weeks, the Home Office has implemented a review of the media license registration process. The new policy stemming from that review was to have taken effect on 01 Jul; however due to varying factors, these changes will now come into effect on 01 Aug 2005. The policy changes and additions are summarized as follows:

- 1. The registered publication understands that should it not publish for a period of at least sixty days, the issued license may be revoked at the discretion of the Ministry of Communications and Information (herein referred to as 'the Ministry') or the Home Office.
- 2. The registered publication agrees to publish special notices of the Royal Government as directed. This measure is being implemented to make the emergency notification communication protocols between the Royal Government and the Gotzborg citizenry more effective and efficient.
- 3. The registered publication understands that if, in a period of thirty days, it does not publish at least 15% Gotzborg-related content (article-wise), the issued license may be reviewed by the Ministry or Home Office and, at the discretion of the aforementioned powers, revoked.

The Home Office will also be working harder to bring online an active list of issued media licenses in an effort to safeguard against publications misrepresenting the endorsement of the Royal Government. The current registration form, Form C&I-2005-01, will continue to be used. For copies of said form, visit the Ministry of Communications & Information website.

Please note that these changes will be made retroactive to all currently effectual media licenses within the Royal Kingdom of Gotzborg. Those publications affected are not required to submit a new registration form on 01 Aug.
